Mission Project: To Drill A Water Well in Africa!



April's Mission Focus is the "Clear Blue Global Water Project". We will be raising funds to drill a water-well in Malawi, Africa. We will be able to maintain a relationship with the community of the Uliwa FMC

where our well will be drilled and see the difference we can make in God's kingdom through something as simple as clean water.

The Uliwa FMC is located in the northern part of Malawi, Karonga District. Karonga is the northern most district of Malawi, with very basic health services and few doctors. Malaria is highly prevalent as well as infections. There are 300 new cases of tuberculosis every year, of which 200 are bacteriologically confirmed. And about 15% of young adults are infected with HIV. Therefore the need for clean water is urgent.

The total cost of our well is \$7,300. The water jug in the narthex is already nearly half full with coins for Africa, save your change and let's fill the jug to overflowing! You can also make larger donations through the offering; just earmark it "Water Well". Or if you can't give today, on the back of the Connection Card is a place where you can pledge an amount you would like to give (then drop it in the offering plate), pray about it and then give your pledge by June 14 as God provides. Let's make a difference globally!
